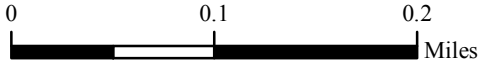
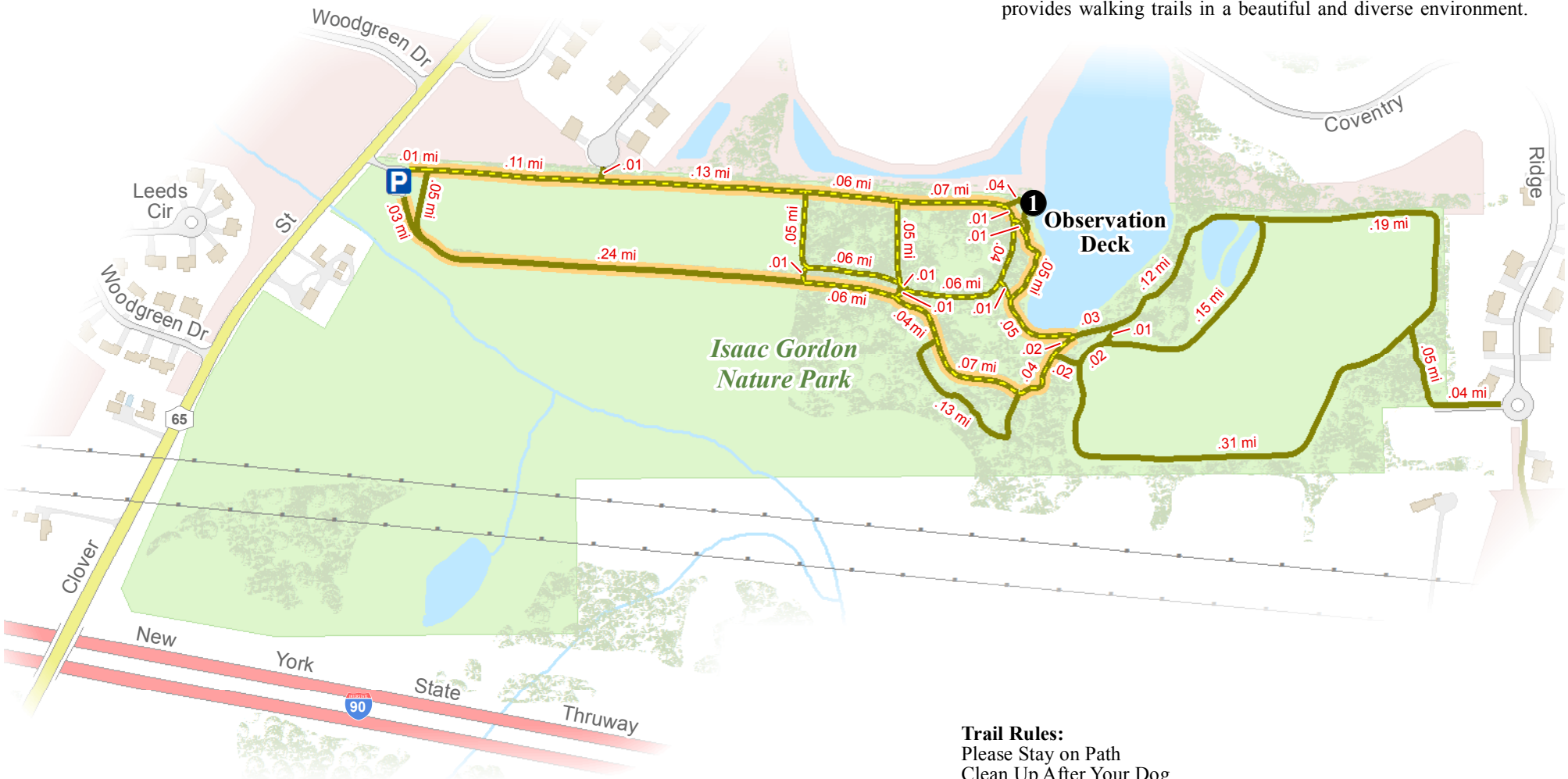
Isaac Gordon Trails

1 Observation Deck

The lumber for the observation deck was generously donated by former Pittsford resident, Jeff Skuse, to replace the old deck that had deteriorated beyond repair. Mr. Skuse grew up in Pittsford and has enjoyed the park for many years as both a child and an adult. In addition to the lumber, the Pittsford Sutherland High School graduate also donated a plaque dedicating the deck to his former environmental science teacher, Gill Petri. Glazer Loop 1.00 Miles

The orange loop utilizes the outermost trails of the Isaac Gordon Nature Park. Dedicated in 1979 on land donated to the Town by the Isaac Gordon Foundation and Dr. Jerome Glazer, Isaac Gordon Nature Park is a passive recreational area that provides walking trails in a beautiful and diverse environment.
