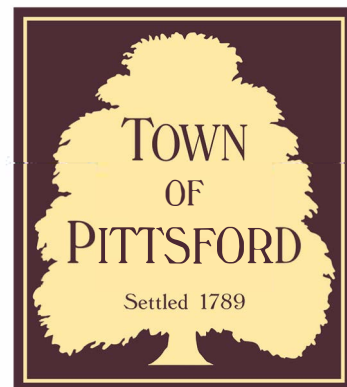
Animal Control

Position: **Animal Control Officer**

(Part-Time)

The Town of Pittsford has an opening for the position listed above.

The candidate must possess the ability to ensure high customer satisfaction when providing assistance to residents regarding domestic and/or wild animals. Typical activities performed will include investigating and taking appropriate action in complaints, recording dog bite reports, maintaining proper files and the capture, restraint and transport of any injured cat or dog to a shelter area, dog licensing and census.

This position is responsible for covering year round, every other weekend and evenings/nights every other week.

The candidate should have a general knowledge of methods and techniques used in capture and restraining of sick or injured animals. The candidate may be required to euthanize sick or injured wild animals, so a general knowledge of firearms is necessary. The candidate must be willing to undergo a series of three rabies shots and will need to attend a training course in animal control.

Annual pay rate \$6,000, paid bi-weekly.

Responding to the Town of Pittsford residents for information and concerns is an important aspect of this job. The candidate must have the ability to communicate effectively with the general public and act as a representative for the Town of Pittsford.

Employees need not be residents of the Town of Pittsford, but shall be required to maintain their primary residence within the County of Monroe or the adjoining counties of Wayne, Ontario, Livingston, Genesee and Orleans within the State of New York. Monroe County Civil Service residency requirements overrule the Town of Pittsford residency for provisional and competitive positions.

The Town of Pittsford provides equal employment opportunities for all employees and applicants for employment. The Town does not discriminate against, or grant preferences to, any person on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, age, ancestry, national origin, marital status, pregnancy, sexual orientation, disability, or any other characteristic protected by federal, state or local law.
